New Equipment

Over the past year, visitors to the shop will have noticed significant improvements aimed at maintaining the quality and variety of both our grocery and café offerings. We've added a

new upright shop freezer, an ice cream fridge, and a produce chiller in the shop, along with new kitchen oven and sandwich equipment. We have also replaced most of our kitchen freezers and refrigerators over the past 12 months. More recently, we've invested in a state-of-the-art Fracino espresso coffee machine and grinder, as well as a fresh meat and drinks chiller, which we were able to purchase in



part thanks to a very generous grant from the Parish Council. Continuously upgrading and replacing equipment is essential to maintaining our shop to the highest standards.

We bid a heartfelt farewell to Poppy and Georgie over the summer. Their contributions on Saturdays have been invaluable since they joined us last October. We are also delighted to welcome our new Saturday team of Rose and Tyler. Their enthusiasm and fresh perspectives are already making a positive impact and they both make brilliant coffee. 
New Garden

Sales This Year

The shop and café are currently in good shape and the total asset value of the business on our balance sheet has increased from £34,437 in July 2023 to £57,813 last month. The graph below shows that our sales over the past 12 months have been above breakeven for every month apart from February. Thanks to your support, we hope to end the year in December with a trading surplus for the first time since 2020. This is a significant achievement and the result of a lot of hard work by all our wonderful staff and volunteers. However, we cannot do this without the continued support of our village.
